Cornelia Ilie is Professor of Linguistics and Rhetoric at Strömstad Academy, Sweden, and Visiting Professor at Hellenic American University, Athens, Greece. She was research scholar at Lancaster University, UK and U.C. Berkeley, and held visiting professorships at universities in Austria, Finland, Greece, Italy, Romania, Spain, and the UK. She is the founder and president of ESTIDIA (European Society for Transcultural and Interdisciplinary Dialogue), Member of the ESF College of Experts, and Board member of IPrA (International Pragmatics Association).



Her research interests are interdisciplinary. She has published extensively on institutional pragmatics and discourse practices (political, media, business and academic discourses), intercultural rhetoric, and argumentation.
