Professor Taher Badinjki is research oriented academic professional. His interest is in English Literature in general, and in the nineteenth-century English Novel in particular, Professor Badinjki's research contribution is more than 25 research papers in journals of international repute, in addition to nine translated and composed books, and a fair number of international conference presentations.



He is a member of world high ranked societies like The Royal Society of Arts in London, and was selected and listed in the Marquis Who's Who in The World, as one of the biographees in the field of English Language and Literature, 25th edition, 2008.

He is actively functioning in different roles as a reviewer, member of the editorial board of many international refereed and specialized journals of English Literature, Humanities and Social Sciences.
